## The Parent/Carer

I/We will:

- Support the School's vision, practices and policies, which are devised for the benefit of my child and his or her learning
- Communicate directly with the school in a civilised and open way, for my child's benefit

- Check daily that my child has completed homework by reading it through and/or helping them to persevere with challenging tasks.
- Ensure my child has the correct equipment each day by checking to see equipment, books and PE kit before they leave the house
- Ensure my child arrives on time ready to work (ready)
- Ensure my child is respectful and allows others to learn (respectful)
- Ensure my child follows instructions immediately (safe)
- Support my child in working hard and putting in effort to their studies, persevering when things get difficult ("If I let you off, I let you down")
- Encourage my child to attend at least 1 extra-curricular activity each week
- Limit the time in the evening on mobile devices, ensuring devices are turned off an hour before bed, charged downstairs and bed time is at an appropriate time for my child's age
- Ensure that my child has excellent attendance (97% or above), avoid doctor's, dentist's etc appointments in school time unless an absolute emergency
- Support the school's practices in regards to rewards and sanctions, including same day detentions
- Register with My Ed app in order to receive communications from the school and monitor it at least weekly, linking home rewards to achievement points received
- Attend all parent events and personalised meetings about my child's progress, being actively involved in supporting my child's life at school
- Only use social media to support or praise the school and community, please be aware of the stress and upset negative posts can cause to members of the school community
- Monitor my child's use of social media and ensure it is used appropriately
