RE: New Year 7 Transition Programme

We would like to welcome you again to the Nicholas Chamberlaine family!

Over the next few weeks Mr Smith, Assistant Head, Ms Boughey, Year Lead, Ms Flounders, Head of Year 7 and the transition team will be liaising with Year 6 teachers and primary schools. They will be finding out key information that will help us to get to know your child.

Unfortunately, the planned open mornings on Friday June 25th and Friday July 2nd and the Transition Day on Wednesday 7th July, where all Year 6 students in the area visit their new secondary school, cannot take place due to continued uncertainty over COVID-19 and a rise in cases in the local area. As a result, we will move all activities online. We are sorry about this but we will ensure that there will be an opportunity to visit school when it is safe to do so at the start of the autumn term. Due to the disruption to your child's learning over the last year or so we are starting the autumn term slightly early on Friday 27th August; this will allow for an extended induction process just for new Year 7 students. We understand that some of our families may have holidays or other events booked, however, the earlier start will help your child with transition so please make every effort to ensure (s)he attends.

There will be lots of information in the transition pack that you will receive and all of the key information will shortly be made available on our website. We will also share it with primary schools so that they can run some sessions in their schools.

We also hope to give you the chance to meet with your child's tutor during the first three weeks of the autumn term, to give you the chance to share any specific information about your child. Mrs Roberts, the SENDCo will also be available on that evening. We will provide you with further information nearer the time.
